Once you open the live wallpaper selector and choose Haunted House HD, the Halloween atmosphere will wash over you. A camera pans out of a creepy house, wrapped in fog as the lights flicker and turn off intermittently. Jack-o-lanterns guard the door and terrifying messages appear over the door with blood. Everything is quite smooth, despite the fact that so much is happening. The door opens and closes on its own, while the camera sweeps back, the lights turn on, revealing a silhouette in the window, and the flag in the mailbox moves up and down on its own. If you want to go inside the house, you need to go to the fully loaded settings menu and change the camera view. The interior of the house is just like (if not more) busy than the exterior. The lights keep flickering, the fire is a pale, ghostly blue, and paintings have skulls over the face of the subject. The ethereal steps pulse and disappear to the floor, and strange breezes explore the chandelier around. It's a lot to take, but it's still a lot of fun. Back to the settings menu, when I said loaded, I meant it. You can choose your camera view, set the name for the mailbox and door, select the kind of person you want for pumpkins, and individually turn on or off any variable that wallpaper has to offer. Subscribe to our newsletter! **FEATURED VIDEOS** Many Saturday morning performances are designed to be educational as well as entertaining. Scooby-Doo, in any of his incarnations, is not among those shows. Young viewers have always been invited to exercise their minds by following the Scooby gang around as they find clues and put them together in a solution, but Scooby's emphasis has never been anything but entertainment. The newest version of the series, Shaggy & Scooby Get A Clue!, is no different. While the program introduces such local complications as global warming and jungle deforestation, it is not done in an educational way. It may be surprising to learn, then, that one of the reasons for creating the original series, Scooby-Doo, Where Are You!, was to satisfy the growing demand for an alternative to action-oriented animations that were increasingly 'violent'. Excessive cartoon violence has been a basis for animation practically since the medium was invented -- though in the early years, no one took it too seriously. That was partly because the cartoons of the 1930s, 40s and 50s weren't made specifically for children -- instead they were aimed at a general theatrical audience. It was only when the cartoons went on TV that they attracted the label of children's things. But in you In the mid-1960s, television networks were increasingly taking heat for violence in children's programming, most notably in action adventure series such as Jonny Quest, The Hercules, and Birdman. Fred Silverman, who was the head of children's programming for CBS, was looking for a show that wouldn't include guns of any kind, extreme cartoon gags involving sticks of dynamite or pans as weapons, or even physical combat. Scooby-Doo, where are you? was designed with many opportunities for slapstick, but there were never any overtly violent acts, not even fighting. Even today, almost forty years later, with Shaggy and Scooby-Doo Get A Clue!, villains are defeated more by deceit and wit than by a tangible threat. In fact, the only time Scooby-Doo and the gang ever made network executives nervous was early in the development period, when the initial treatment for the show was deemed too scary for a young audience. Of course, the ghost, ghoul, or monster the gang happens to encounter is not usually a supernatural creature at all, but rather a human criminal in disguise. Inevitably, the gang exposes him. Now that we have the background for the cartoons, how about details about the stars themselves? In the next section, we cover Scooby, Shaggy and the whole gang. YouTube announced that it will allow users to upload and view the video in full HD; a 1080p test video is now available. All of you viewers with fast computers and even faster broadband connections will soon get to indulge in much more. It's been about a year since the Google-owned broadcaster made 720p video available. In this time, full-HD camcorders have become relatively common and more than YouTube content has been uploaded as 1080p, although it was not undying as such. The company plans to re-encode all this previously created material so that viewers will be able to take advantage of its original analysis. It's hard to believe that YouTube has only been around for just over four years. It won't be the first video sharing site to offer full HD, but it will almost certainly be the one to bring it to the masses. Alternately mocked and for blockbusters like Charlie Bit My Finger, YouTube has recently become eager to showcase commercial content and compete with the likes of Hulu, a joint venture of three major broadcast networks. Last spring, YouTube began offering some high-quality content from Hollywood; the premium term should be used loosely, however, since the options were subtle. In September, Wall Street reported [subscription required] that YouTube was in serious talks with major film studios about streaming movies on a rental basis. The switch to 1080p should support these initiatives. It's possible that YouTube could provide Blu-ray quality streams for paid content. For regular folk, full HD will mean the opportunity to share these bloopers and family videos on a wall-size screen. Would-be actives should be aware that, for now, YouTube will still limit user-generated content to 10 minutes in length. It seems plausible, however, that the current 2GB file-size limit will get a lift, considering how monstrously large these 1080p videos will be. Get the cameras rolling!
